

Uig Community Voucher Scheme

Whilst the Highland region has remained in tier one the impact of restrictions elsewhere is certainly being felt by our community. The Community Trust, with the support of the Supporting Communities Fund, has decided to reintroduce the voucher scheme from today. The vouchers can be used for purchases of groceries of food, non alcoholic drinks and logs, they cannot be used for the purchase of cigarettes, alcohol, lottery, fuel or electricity. The vouchers can be redeemed at Rankins Supermarket and the Filling Station.

How much are the vouchers for?

The value of the vouchers available is dependent on the number of people in the household; a family can request up to £30, a couple £25 and a single person household £20.

Who can you apply for a voucher?

If you are living in the area covered by either the Uig or Kilmuir Community Trusts then you can apply.

How can you apply for a voucher?

Is there are a limit on the number of vouchers that can be requested?

1 voucher per week can be requested by a household, we will be issuing vouchers to cover a 2 week period (ie £60 for a family), if another voucher is required after this time you please submit another request.
